- Raise key issues and risks to delivery throughout the process.
- Suggest business improvements based on best practices.

Responsibilities

- Develop a deep understanding of customers, their work environment and strategic goals to identify their business challenges and provide a thoughtful partnership to define solution options.
- Build positive, constructive partnering relationships with key stakeholder groups, including senior leaders.
- Lead business process modeling, process design and requirements working sessions with business stakeholders, domain experts and users to define and document business cases, scope, process and policy inventories, and high-level and detailed business and non-functional requirements.
- Evaluate existing business systems in collaboration with subject matter experts (both business and technical) to determine changes and enhancements required to meet business needs.
- Define user stories, use cases and associated process-related requirements and document them in a digestible and actionable format.
- Facilitate user-experience prototyping to validate requirements.
- Work collaboratively in the design, development and testing of solutions.
- Resolve conflicts between business requirements and technical and practical constraints.

- Ensure traceability of requirements to confirm that functional requirements and technical designs map to business requirements.
- Partner with other project team members to build solutions to deliver business goals.
- Document change requests and coordinate business and technical review.
- Test business processes as they are developed, integrated and released, and document issues.
- Recognize and track business issues and decision conflicts, escalate as appropriate and coordinate resolution.
- Support project and sustainment release transition into production.
- Collaborate with the Project Manager to track work process and identify risks and impediments to project timeline.

Required Qualifications

- Minimum of eight years of relevant professional experience as a Business Analyst, Data Analyst, or equivalent in a software development environment.
- Advanced analytic thinking, research mindset and problem-solving skills, with the ability to frame problems, structure analysis, summarize findings and present coherent conclusions and insights.
- Demonstrated experience writing business requirements and functional specifications for complex systems.
- Advanced interviewing and negotiation skills applicable to identifying, defining and evaluating requirements.
- Demonstrated intermediate to advanced experience with business process re-engineering and business modeling concepts.
- Strong operational business understanding, including potential impact of business decisions on various internal/external stakeholders and systems.
- Experience diving into quantitative information with an eye for details.
- Experience with Agile and Waterfall software development practices, teams and deliverables.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
